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Cong cold-shouldered Armed Forces and denied OROP: Modi

Saluting the indomitable courage of the Indian Armed Forces, Prime Minister Narendra Modi alleged on Wednesday that successive Congress dispensations kept the military reliant on foreign weapons, deprived soldiers stationed on the border of improved facilities and denied the benefit of One Rank One Pension (OROP) to ex-servicemen.

Addressing a public meeting in this headquarters of Chambal division from where thousands of youngsters have donned the olive-green uniform down the decades, the visiting dignitary averred, "It is imperative for today's youth to comprehend that the Congress always played with the vital sphere of national security. After the attainment of Independence,



one of the first scams perpetrated by the Congress was in the defence sector."

The present-day indigenously-equipped Indian Army deals a fitting response to terrorists in their own language and even delivers the reply in militants' dens, the Prime Minister underlined. In the

context of OROP, he said, "Everyone knows full well that for four long decades, the Congress turned a deaf ear to our soldiers. Those bravehearts - who serve the nation with a burning passion that is willing to sacrifice everything for the cause - were distraught vis-à-vis the Congress' attitude."

That party's dispensation earmarked a paltry Rs 500 crore, uttered untruth to the warriors, gave hollow guarantees with regard to implementation of OROP, misguided, confused and threw dust in the eyes of the soldiers, Modi thundered, adding that dishonesty was a hallmark of Congress

Terror funding case : SI A raids 22 locations in Kashmir & New Delhi

SRINAGAR : (AGENCY)

Jammu and Kashmir Police's State Investigation Agency (SIA) on Wednesday conducted raids at 22 locations in Kashmir and New Delhi as part of the probe in the alleged terror funding case. The pre-dawn searches were carried out simultaneously by special teams of SIA at 18 places in Srinagar, one each in Anantnag and Pulwama, besides two in Delhi, officials of the anti terror Agency said.

"During the search operation, incriminating material in the shape of bank documents, cash books, credit cards, debit cards, cheque books, invoices, mobile phones, sim cards, passports etc. were seized which will be analyzed for further investigation," they said. The case pertains to illegal raising, layering and laundering of illegal proceeds of crime by the accused persons which subsequently might have been used in unlawful activities including secessionism and terrorism. The case was registered in SIA Kashmir police station on the basis of an enquiry. "During enquiry, it has been found that funds to the tune of INR 85 crore have been raised and laundered in a short span of less than two years. The transactions have mostly taken place in cash to evade detection of law enforcement agencies. Based on the findings of the enquiry, a case with FIR No 08 of 2023 was

registered under relevant sections of law," a statement by SIA said. Today's raids were conducted on the strength search warrant issued by the Special Designated NIA Court to collect evidence relevant to the ongoing investigation in the case.

The Agency reiterated its commitment to dismantle the terror ecosystem in J&K by chocking terror financing channels be it hawala, human cash couriers or banking channels.

Govt releases guidelines for scrapyards in state

PANAJI : OPEN SEARCH

Scrapyards in the state may soon become a regulated industry with the government coming out with a proposal to make the scrap dealers comply with regulations of at least seven different government departments. The Goa State Pollution Control Board (GSPCB) has unveiled the draft guidelines for scrapyards which call for the facilities to be compliant with regulations of the town and country planning (TCP) department, health department, labour & employment department, revenue department, Goa Industrial Development Corporation, directorate of fire and emergency services as well as the bylaws of panchayats and municipalities. According to the guidelines, the land on which a scrap yard is located must measure up to the standards of the GSPCB and the TCP department. The guidelines also say that the area used for waste collection should not be waterlogged and it must be fenced and made of concrete. The guidelines further mention the mode of waste treatment at scrap yards stating that all recycled waste should be sent to GSPCB-empowered recyclers and the non-recyclable waste should be disposed of only through approved means viz. co-processing at cement kilns, waste to energy, etc. Scrapyards must have permanent electricity and water connections and all workers should be registered with the labour and employment department, state the guidelines.

Release detainees who doesn't have serious allegations : Omar demands authorities

SRINAGAR : (AGENCY)

National Conference Vice President Omar Abdullah on Wednesday demanded that the authorities in Jammu and Kashmir should start the process of releasing the detainees who do not have serious allegations. Talking to media



persons on the sidelines of a public rally at north Kashmir's Bandipora district on Wednesday, Omar said that the people who have been arrested especially after 2019 should be released immediately now.

He said those against whom there are no serious allegations, a process to release them should be started immediately. The NC Vice President said during the all-party meeting held in New Delhi chaired by the Prime Minister, it was also decided that the people who do not have seri-

ous allegations would be released in Jammu and Kashmir. The former Chief Minister alleged that people of Jammu and Kashmir are passing through hardship for the past five years. He reiterated that employees should have a way to protest in order to meet their genuine demands. The authorities in Jammu and Kashmir banned government employees for participating in demonstrations and strikes. Omar said nobody wants the employees to come out on the roads to resort violence or in offices or to resort to stone pelting. "In democracy, everybody has his right to protest for his genuine demands and similarly employees should also have such a way to protest for meeting them", he said. Regarding the snapping of internet facilities in south Kashmir' Pulwama district yesterday, Omar said if the internet facility was snapped in pulwama, people should have been told the reason behind why it was barred. "People are not fools neither they are so harsh that they can lodge a protest. But they definitely would like to learn what makes the authorities snap the internet.

Arunachal BJP sweeps panchayat bypoll

ITANAGAR (AGENCY) The ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) in Arunachal Pradesh has swept the Panchayat by-election by securing over 72 per cent Gram Panchayat (GP) seats, besides winning both the Zilla

Parishad (ZP) constituencies in the recently held election, the results of which were declared on Wednesday.

Remarkably, of the 54 GP constituencies that went to by-poll, 39 were captured by the ruling party, reg-

istering a 72.22 percent success rate. Of them, 37 GP seats were won by BJP uncontested and five seats by opposition Congress, according to the State Election Commission (SEC). While 49 GP constituencies.



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Neither public nor party takes Rahul Gandhi seriously : Yogi

Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister launched an attack on Congress and said that its leader Rahul Gandhi has gone to Kedarnath to pray to God in times of crisis as his party is set to lose the assembly elections.

On the second consecutive day of campaigning in support of Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) candidates in Madhya Pradesh, Yogi said, "Rahul ji is convinced that Congress is losing badly in the semi-finals of the assembly elections and therefore has run away. He lacks the guts to face the elections." He said, "The absence of the former Congress president at the last moment of the elections shows that neither his party, nor the public takes him seriously." The UP CM said that when the Congress government was in power at the centre and



in the state, it abandoned victims of the Kedarnath tragedy. "People kept wandering for many months, but the government did not help them. As the CM of Gujarat Modi ji sought permission from the centre to help the victims, but was denied it," he said.

He alleged, "They had destroyed Kedarnath, but when PM Modi and the Uttarakhnd government got an opportunity, they

beautified Kedarnath Dham. If you hold a flower in your hand, its fragrance and softness will give you pleasure, but if you hold a scorpion in your hand, it will definitely bite."

Yogi narrated the story of the transformation of UP in the last six and a half years and invited the people of Madhya Pradesh to come to Ayodhya. Urging people to vote for the BJP candidate Brijendra Pratap Singh

from Panna assembly constituency, he said, "This entire area is connected to Bundelkhand of UP. People go from here to there in the name of education, health, employment and farming, hence this area is not far from us. The activities going on within both the states have an impact on each other's areas."

The UP CM said, "We are building a new Noida. It took 46 years to build Noida near Delhi, which spreads over an area of 33,000 acres of land. We are going to settle 38,000 acres in Jhansi and Bundelkhand in the first phase itself. New industries will be established here and the youth will get employment. Be it UP or MP the aim of both the governments is to serve the people." Appealing to people to vote in favour of Shishupal Yadav from Prithvipur assembly constituency.

Over 60 workers of Imran Khan’s party arrested in Lahore in connection with May 9 attacks

LAHORE : (AGENCY)

More than 60 leaders and workers of jailed former prime minister Imran Khan’s Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) party have been arrested here in Punjab province in connection with the attacks on military installations in May, police said on Wednesday, an act described as “illegal fascist measures” by the party. Police action against the PTI leaders and workers has been intensified across the country following the announcement of general elections in Pakistan on February 8, 2024.

These are fresh arrests in addition to those already arrested on May 9 and soon after. According to the PTI, over 10,000 of its leaders and workers have been in jail since early May in connection with attacks on military and state installations following Khan’s arrest in an alleged corruption case. “The police arrested 62 PTI workers involved in the May 9 attack on Lahore Corps Commander House and torching of a plaza (allegedly owned by the son of former army chief Gen



Qamar Javed Bajwa) in different parts of the city on Tuesday,” a Lahore police statement said on Wednesday. It said a crackdown has been launched against those involved in attacks on military installations but evaded arrest. A heavy contingent of police also raided the residence of PTI president Chaudhry Parvez Elahi to arrest his relative and former lawmaker Maj (R) Tahir Sadiq. Elahi is already in jail. PTI senior leader and

former federal minister Moonis Elahi said the Punjab police’s brutalities against the PTI leaders and workers are at their peak as they are not sparing even women. On May 9, following the arrest of Khan by paramilitary Rangers, unrest broke out in Pakistan that saw the torching and vandalising of dozens of military and state buildings, including the Army headquarters in Rawalpindi and the ISI building in Faisalabad.

Police arrested over 10,000 workers of PTI, and over 100 are being tried under the Army Act. The PTI core committee has also strongly denounced the “state’s coercive tactics, reprisal actions” against the PTI workers and leaders even after the announcement of the polls date. “We condemn the illegal fascist measures of the state against peaceful political activities before the elections. The nation will not accept rigged polls held in such an uneven electoral

field and with state interference,” it said and added that after fixing the date of the poll, the reprehensible attempts to force the PTI out of the electoral arena and deprive it of a level playing field have become more prominent before the world. The PTI core committee asked the Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP) to avoid playing the role of a vacillator in poll rigging (and) rather it should ensure a level playing field for all political parties to hold free, fair and transparent elections in the country. It also paid glowing tribute to PTI chairman Imran Khan for facing the “unjustifiable” incarceration with steadfastness, courage and perseverance. “The PTI will take part in the elections and Imran Khan will lead the party’s election campaign across the country,” it said and added Khan has been in jail for over 100 days without any legal justification. and was being merely subjected to political revenge. Khan has been lodged at Adiala Jail at Rawalpindi in the cipher case in which he is accused of leaking state secrets.A

Fleeing Gaza is ‘horror movie on repeat’, says Suzan Beseiso who finally escaped after four failed attempts

CAIRO : (AGENCY)

It took four failed attempts before Suzan Beseiso was able to get through the Rafah crossing into Egypt and escape the bombardment of the Gaza Strip. On each occasion, the 31-year-old Palestinian American, one of several hundred foreign passport holders allowed to leave the enclave since last week, said she faced acute danger.

“Every single time we went to the border, we got bombed and freaked out” she said on Sunday during an interview in Cairo, where she arrived after crossing the Sinai Peninsula by road “Bombs are going left and right.” After Israel imposed a total siege on Gaza in retaliation for an October 7 incursion by Hamas, the Rafah crossing — the only crossing out of Gaza that does not border Israel — remained out of operation for nearly two weeks amid diplomatic wrangling over conditions for allowing aid to enter and evacuees to leave. Since then a trickle of relief has been trucked into Gaza and some evacuees have left,



though the arrangement is fragile and was suspended on Saturday before resuming on Monday. The month-long war has caused a deepening humanitarian crisis in Gaza as Israel’s military campaign has intensified, with many of the territory’s 2.3 million inhabitants repeatedly displaced as they struggle to find shelter and safety. Beseiso, who has spent about half her life in Gaza and half in the U.S., said she had crammed with relatives into a single room in a stranger’s house, ran short of food and water, and endured sleepless nights during air strikes.

“It’s just a horror movie that keeps putting on repeat” she said. “No sleep. No food. No water. You keep evacuating from one place

to another.” On one occasion, she was in a resting-area next to the border with her sister and cousin and panicked when she heard a strike fall near where her mother, father, and nephew were waiting outside. They narrowly escaped, she said, but the Palestinians received an order to shut the border and the family retreated in a terrifying taxi ride back into Gaza. “On our way to the house, gunships were bombing the beach area, and the bombs were just flying on top of our heads, left and right, and the airplanes.

were just bombing as well” Eventually, the first foreigners and some Palestinians requiring urgent medical treatment

Record 7.5 million people globally diagnosed with tuberculosis in 2022 : WHO

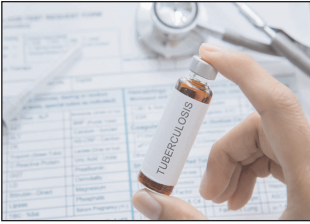
NEW DELHI : (AGENCY)

A total of 7.5 million people were diagnosed with tuberculosis in 2022, the highest recorded since WHO began global TB monitoring in 1995, according to a report featuring data from 192 countries and areas. The World Health Organization (WHO) 2023 Global tuberculosis (TB) report also shows that globally, an estimated 10.6 million people fell ill with TB in 2022, up from 10.3 million in 2021.

The report underscores a significant worldwide recovery in the scale-up of TB diagnosis and treatment services in 2022. It shows an encouraging trend starting to reverse the detrimental effects of COVID- 19 disruptions on TB services. The increase in diagnosis is attributed to good recovery

in access to and provision of health services in many countries, WHO said.

India, Indonesia and the Philippines, which together accounted for over 60 per cent of the global reduc-



tions in the number of people newly diagnosed with TB in 2020 and 2021, all recovered to beyond 2019 levels in 2022, it said. “For millennia, our ancestors suffered and died with tuberculosis, without knowing what it was, what caused it, or how to stop it,” said Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus.

Five members of two Indian-origin families killed after SUV crashes into pub in Melbourne

Five members of two Indian-origin families in Australia, including two children have been killed when a luxury SUV ploughed into a packed outdoor dining area of a pub here, leaving the Indian community devastated. Vivek Bhatia (38), his son Vihan (11), Pratibha Sharma (44), her daughter, Anvi (nine), and partner Jatin Chugh (30) died after the BMW mounted a kerb and hit patrons on the front

lawn of the Royal Daylesford hotel on Sunday evening, the Sydney Morning Herald reported.

Sharma and her family were enjoying a holiday with family friends, Bhatia and his son Vihan, who died instantly in the crash, while Bhatia’s 36-year-old wife, Ruchi, and six-year-old son Abeer were taken to hospital with serious injuries, the report said. Abeer was initially in critical condition with broken legs and internal injuries but has since been sta-

bilised. There are many others, including a baby, who were injured in the accident and have been shifted to a hospital for treatment. The driver of the white BMW Sports Utility Vehicle has been interviewed by police in hospital following the crash. The unnamed man, a 66-year-old from Mount

Macedon, was spoken to by police on Tuesday but was not arrested or charged.

“At this time the driver has not been charged, with inquiries to continue after his eventual release from care,” a police statement provided to the Herald Sun said. Meanwhile, the distraught family of one of the

crash victims, Sharma, has revealed their final conversation with the beloved mum. Her father Vikas said she had spoken to her mother Urmila just two hours before her death. “She said they were staying in a beautiful house all together,” he told the Herald Sun. Urmila said: “She said:

tomorrow I will come (home) early”. She said they tried to call Pratibha later that night but there was “no reply”. “We thought it was okay and there was no need to disturb them because they were enjoying themselves,” he said, expressing his disbelief at his hard-working.

दशहरे पर कार्यक्रम देखने गए युवक की छाती में छूरी से वारकर हत्या के दो आरोपी दोषी करार

हिसार (एजेंसी) पांच साल पहले दशहरे पर कार्यक्रम देखने गए युवक की छाती में छूरी से वारकर हत्या करने के मामले में अतिरिक्त जिला एवं सत्र न्यायाधीश डा. गगनदीप मित्तल की अदालत ने दो आरोपितों को दोषी करार दिया है। सजा नौ नवंबर को सुनाई जाएगी।

अदालत में चले अभियोग के अनुसार अक्टूबर 2018 में टेकड़ा मोहल्ल के शिवा ने सिटी थाना में केस दर्ज करवाया था कि वो दो भाई हैं। वो अपने बड़े भाई रोहित के साथ 19 अक्टूबर 2018 को दशहरा का प्रोग्राम देखने मुलतानी चौक पार्क में गया हुआ था। शाम करीब बजे पार्क में बने तीन पुतलों को जला दिया था। इस दौरान भीड़ में आए व्यक्ति जलती हुई लकड़ियों को पुतलों से बाहर खींच रहे थे। वो दोनों भाई उन लकड़ियों को वापस पुतलों में डाल कर जला रहे थे।
